

Thornapple/Robley Septic to Sanitary Sewer Conversion

PLEASE PLAN TO ATTEND

Mayfield Village is preparing to move forward with the conversion of septic to sanitary sewers on Thornapple Drive, Robley Lane and portions of Wilson Mills Road. This project will involve the installation of new water, storm and sanitary sewer lines and replacement of the roadway.

Fabrizi Trucking & Paving has been awarded this project at a cost of \$2.95 million. Work is expected to begin in April with completion of the entire project by November 2018.
