

**MINUTES OF THE  
SAFETY & SERVICE COMMITTEE  
Tuesday, January 3, 2012 at 7:30 p.m.

The Safety and Service Committee met on Tuesday, January 3, 2012 in the Mayfield Village Civic Hall at the Mayfield Village Civic Center. Mrs. Cinco called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

**POLICE DEPARTMENT**

Chief Edelman reported that with the exception of the first item, all items on the agenda relating to the Police Department are annual fees. They are on the agenda as they relate to safety.

. **Prisoner housing for remainder of 2011**

Chief Edelman reported that this item is for prisoner housing, City of Bedford Heights, for the remainder of 2011.

. **Prisoner housing for 2012**

Dr. Parker asked if anything has changed since last year.

Chief Edelman replied, yes, the amount is up \$1,000 more from last year.

. **Monthly TAC fees for CAD and Olen for 2012**

Chief Edelman reported, this is for our computerized dispatch system.

Mrs. Cinco asked, has anything changed?

Chief Edelman replied, no. It is the same amount.

. **Cleaning of new police station for 2012**

Mrs. Cinco asked, how are the services going for this?

Chief Edelman replied, going well. They replaced the first person who was cleaning the police station because we were having problems. Since then, we have had no problems.

Mr. Marrie asked, is it just one person?

Chief Edelman replied, yes. The services are provided 2 ½ days a week. For the half day, they empty the trash.

. **Monthly CRIS/LEADS/NCIC usage for 2012**

Chief Edelman reported, this is the same as last year.

**FIRE DEPARTMENT**

. **Hydrant usage – Cleveland Water Department**

Chief Mohr reported, I do not have an amount at this time. I should have it before the Finance Committee meeting. It is for use of the fire hydrants and maintenance and water out of the hydrants.

Mr. Marrie asked, does this include the soccer fields?

Chief Mohr replied, no.

Mr. Metzger added, fees are additional for water for recreation.

Dr. Parker asked, how are we doing on the problems?

Chief Mohr replied, we came through it at the next meeting. They are replacing hydrants. The hydrants on SOM are deteriorating because of the salt. They were painted this year. They put a fitting on. It looks like a plate. You take our hose and click click instead of the screw. There are 8 fittings on 10 of them. Those hydrants were replaced before they put the new fittings in.

Mrs. Mills asked if there were hydrants not working.

Chief Mohr replied, I went up to Sherwin Williams for the non-working hydrant. It is working. It received a fitting.

Dr. Parker suggested this be passed on to Finance.

. **MARCS - 2012**

Chief Mohr reported this is for police and fire. There is a price reduction coming. Right now it will be the same amount as last year. The majority of our radios will switch to the new system.

Mr. Metzger replied, Service is getting all new radios by the end of the year because they are not allowed to use the old ones. It is not a budget buster.

Chief Mohr added, this is narrow banding. It is a Federal requirement. The radios will last 20 years. The old ones will not be legal after January 1, 2013. If they are used, there is a \$500 per day fine per radio. Purchase of the new ones are already in the works.

Dr. Parker asked, is there any grant money?

Chief Mohr replied, no.

**PARKS & RECREATION**

. **Fireworks – 2012 (Zambelli)**

Mr. Thomas reported, this is the last year. The price is \$14,600. We start the process early and get it approved so that we can get back right away to Mr. Richards.

Mrs. Mills asked, since this is the last year, are you checking for other bids?

Mr. Thomas replied, we are testing the waters. We are happy with Zambelli. There may be other companies out there to compare apples to apples, provided they follow the stringent laws. Dave and I will research other companies. If we are talking a savings, it would behoove us to check and make a recommendation to Council for 2013.

Mrs. Mills stated, Bill worked diligently with Chief Mohr to ensure that the fireworks were safe.

Mr. Thomas stated, safety first.

Mr. Marrie stated, we have been satisfied with Zambelli.


Chief Mohr stated, that company would be our first choice. Because they have electronic firing, it allowed us to shoot off the fireworks last year even though a storm started to kick in.
