

**MINUTES OF THE

The Safety and Service Committee met on Monday, October 1, 2012 in the Mayfield Village Conference Room at the Mayfield Village Civic Center. Mrs. Cinco called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

Lieutenant Jablonski stated, we have our two new police vehicles and equipment and a new motorcycle for 2013.

Mrs. Cinco asked, anything new to report? This is just our usual turnover? Lieutenant Jablonski stated, actually we should have been purchasing three vehicles but we saved some money and are purchasing a motorcycle instead.

Mrs. Cinco asked if there were any questions. There were none.

Mrs. Mills commented, good report. Mrs. Cinco agreed.

**PARKS & RECREATION**

- . **Fireworks 2013**

Mr. Thomas reported, Zambelli Fireworks' display contract expired. It was for three years. I mentioned to Dave that I wanted to go out and look at other companies that shot off fireworks. We sent out an RFP to Zambelli, American Fireworks and Pyrotecnico Fireworks. They shot off at the Lakeside area. We got all of the proposals back. I provided Council on the Safety and Service Committee with a copy of those proposals. We are not talking about money right now

because it is a Safety and Service matter. Dave, Mike Girbino and myself looked at it from a safety standpoint. All companies met the safety requirements. We are looking at American Fireworks as far as their show. I know Mike had a question and he did receive a response from American Fireworks.

Mr. Thomas asked Chief Mohr, if the Finance Department approves the expenditure, would you feel comfortable with using American Fireworks? That's my recommendation to this Committee. Chief Mohr did not see any problems.

Mrs. Cinco asked, \$9,000 or \$14,000? Mr. Thomas stated, that's for Finance.

Mr. Marrie asked, with your rave reviews and the Chiefs about Zambelli's record, why did you get away from them? Mr. Thomas replied, I was looking at it from the taxpayer's standpoint. American Fireworks came back with \$9,000 for the same show. You can go back to Zambelli for \$14,600.

Mr. Marrie asked, what was Zambelli last year? Mr. Thomas replied, \$14,600. He's \$14,600 this coming year. You can then look at a show that American Fireworks would do almost double what Zambelli did for \$14,000.

Mr. Wynne asked, you would choose the program for \$9,000? Mr. Thomas replied, the same program that Zambelli would give us would be for \$9,000, or we could get double what we got last year for \$14,000.

Mrs. Cinco stated, Finance can decide what they want to do.

Mrs. Cinco asked, are there any other questions?

Mr. Marrie asked, do we have to sign three years? Mr. Thomas replied, at this point, I was advised by our Law Department that I can't go over \$20,000. Even with \$9,000 times three, that's \$27,000. I can't go over the \$20,000, which is the limit. I do not want to go out to bid. I want to keep it within this if we can and leave it at one year which would be under the \$20,000.

Mr. Marrie asked, what's the \$20,000 number that's so magic? Mr. Wynne clarified, it's \$25,000. If we go over that number, we have to go out and advertise for bids.

Mr. Thomas stated, if Council decides to go with the all-out program for three years, that would be \$28,000. If you keep it at one year, whether it be \$14,000 or \$9,000, you are still under the \$25,000.

Mrs. Cinco stated, they are a different company than we used before. It might be smarter to try them for a year and see. Mr. Thomas agreed. That would be my recommendation. Mr. Marrie agreed.

Mr. Thomas stated, Finance Committee can pass on to Council whether it will be \$14,000 or \$9,000.

Mr. Marrie asked, \$9,000 gives us exactly what we had this year? Mr. Thomas replied, yes.

Mrs. Cinco suggested we try it for one year and then the following year evaluate it. Tom and Patsy, it will be up to the Finance Committee to decide which way to go.


Mrs. Cinco asked if there were any further matters. There were none.
