ORDINANCE NO. 2011-17

INTRODUCED BY: Mayor Rinker and Council as a Whole

**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE
REPEALING SECTION 1173.07
OF THE VILLAGE'S CODIFIED ORDINANCES ITS ENTIRETY.**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance Number 2010-41, the Village amended Chapter 1183 regarding Off-Street Parking and Loading requirements; and

WHEREAS, at this time Section 1173.07 regarding Off-Street Parking and Loading has been found to be in conflict; and

WHEREAS, the Village has deemed it in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of all residents to specifically repeal Section 1173.07, so as to fully promote the requirements of Chapter 1183.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF MAYFIELD VILLAGE, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. That Section 1173.07, Off-Street Parking and Loading of the Village's Codified Ordinances be repealed in its entirety and reference made thereto Chapter 1183.

SECTION 2. All other provisions of the Village's Codified Ordinances not inconsistent herewith shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. The Clerk of Council is authorized and directed forward a certified copy of this Ordinance to the Codifier of the Village of Mayfield.

SECTION 4. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the residents of Mayfield Village, Ohio. It shall, therefore, take effect immediately upon the passage by the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members elected to Council and approval by the Mayor or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.




