

ORDINANCE NO. 2012-15
INTRODUCED BY: Mayor Rinker and Council as a Whole

**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE
AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH METLIFE
AS AND FOR AN EMPLOYEE AD&D, LIFE
AND DENTAL PROGRAM.**

WHEREAS, the Health Care Task Force and the Finance Committee have recommended and it is the desire of Council to authorize an AD&D, life and dental plan for employees with MetLife.

WHEREAS, due to a decrease in employee participation necessitating a minor increase in rates, the previous legislation, Ordinance No. 2012-13, passed by Mayfield Village Council at a Special Meeting on March 5, 2012, is hereby revised to reflect this increase.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MAYFIELD, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA (the "Entity") AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1. The Mayor and President of Council are hereby and herein authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with MetLife for AD&D and life, effective April 1, 2012, the cost of which shall be \$0.287 per thousand dollars of coverage per month; and for an employee dental program as stipulated therein, at the rate of \$30.63 per month per employee for single coverage, \$61.95 per month for employee and spouse, \$69.32 per month for employee and children, and \$104.50 per month for employee, spouse and children.

SECTION 2. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary to maintain the employee AD&D, life and dental program for the employees of Mayfield Village, Ohio which is due to expire on April 1, 2012. It shall, therefore, take effect immediately upon the passage by the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members elected to

Council and approval by the Mayor or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.






