

ORDINANCE NO. 2012-04

INTRODUCED BY: Mayor Rinker and Council as a Whole

**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE
DISBANDING THE BEAUTIFICATION COMMITTEE**

WHEREAS, at this time, based upon the recommendation of the Village Administration, it has been deemed in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the Village and its residents to specifically disband the Beautification Committee; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF MAYFIELD VILLAGE, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Beautification Committee shall be considered disbanded as of the effective date of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. All other provisions of the Village's Ordinances not inconsistent herewith shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the residents of Mayfield Village, Ohio. It shall, therefore, take effect immediately upon the passage by the

affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members elected to Council and approval by the Mayor or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.






