**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE
REPEALING IN ITS ENTIRETY
CODIFIED ORDINANCE SECTION 171.04 OF THE
CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF MAYFIELD VILLAGE, OHIO
RELATING TO THE CERTIFICATION OF REGISTRATION
FEE AND POSTING FOR LODGINGS IN THE VILLAGE.**

WHEREAS, at this time, and in accordance with the recommendations of the Ordinance Review Committee and Finance Director, as it has been deemed in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of all Village residents to specifically repeal Section 171.04 of the Village's Codified Ordinances to update the Code to conform to the Village's current practices which do not require a Certificate of Registration nor fee for such Certificate from places of lodging for transient guests in the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF MAYFIELD VILLAGE, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. That Codified Ordinance Section 171.04 of the Codified Ordinances of Mayfield Village shall be repealed in its entirety. A copy of Ordinance 90-26 adopting this section and increasing the fee from \$1.00 to \$15.00 is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. All other provisions of the Village's Codified Ordinances not inconsistent herewith shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. The Clerk of Council is authorized and directed forward a certified copy of this Ordinance to the Codifier of the Village of Mayfield.

SECTION 4. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING SECTION 171.04 OF THE
CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF MAYFIELD VILLAGE, OHIO,
INCREASING THE FEES FOR THE CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION
FOR PLACES THAT PROVIDE LODGING OF TRANSIENT GUESTS AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF MAYFIELD VILLAGE, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. Section 171.04 of the Codified Ordinance of Mayfield Village, Ohio, is hereby amended to increase the fees for a Certificate of Registration for places that provide lodging of transient guests so that new Section 171.04 shall read as follows: (Deleted material appears like this and new material appears like THIS)

Chapter 171

Excise Tax on Lodgings

* * *

171.04 CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION; FEE; POSTING.

Any person conducting or operating any place for lodging for transient guests shall, on a form prescribed by the Finance Director, within the first ten days of each calendar year, or within ten days after commencing such operations, make application to and procure from the Finance Director, a certificate of registration, the fee for which shall be ~~one dollar (\$1.00)~~ FIFTEEN DOLLARS (\$15.00), which certificate shall continue valid until December 31 of the year in which the same is issued. Such certificate of registration, or duplicate original copies thereof to be issued by the Finance Director without additional charge, shall be posted in a conspicuous place upon the premises.

SECTION 2. All prior Ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance in whole or in part, are repealed to the extent necessary to avoid conflict with this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the residents of Mayfield Village, Ohio, for the reason that such legislation is required to maintain efficient governmental services. It shall, therefore, take effect immediately upon the passage by the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members elected to Council and approval by the Mayor or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.
