**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE
AMENDING SECTION 1333.01 OF THE
VILLAGE'S CODIFIED ORDINANCES ADOPTING
THE 2011 EDITION OF THE NATIONAL FIRE PROTECTION
ASSOCIATION N.F.P.A. - 70 NATIONAL ELECTRIC CODE.**

WHEREAS, at this time, due to the publishing of the 2011 Edition of the National Fire Protection Association N.F.P.A . - 70 National Electric Code, it has been deemed in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of all Village residents to specifically amend Section 1333.01 to adopt as the Electrical Code of Mayfield Village, the “2011 Edition of the National Fire Protection Association N.F.P.A. - 70 National Electric Code.”

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF MAYFIELD VILLAGE, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. Section 1333.01 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village pertaining to the Electrical Code of Mayfield Village, is hereby and herein amended to read as follows:

1333.01 ADOPTION; ENFORCEMENT.

(a) The National Electric Code of 2011, as well as any subsequent updates, addenda or amendments to the Code, is hereby adopted and incorporated by reference as part of the Mayfield Village Building Code as if fully set forth herein, save and except such portions herein that maybe deleted, modified or amended . The purpose of the National Electric Code is to provide minimum standards so that all electrical materials and installations in dwelling units of One, Two and Three Family Dwellings, mobile homes, multiple family dwellings, commercial occupancies and industrial occupancies shall be in accordance with the requirements of the National Electric Code N.F.P.A – 70 sponsored by the National Fire Protection Association.

(b) The National Electric Code shall be enforced by the Building Commissioner and the Electrical Safety Inspector.

SECTION 2. All other references in Chapter 1333 to the Electric Code or National Electric Code shall mean the 2011 Edition, as well as any subsequent updates, addenda, or amendments to the National Fire Protection Association N.F.P.A. - 70 National Electric Code. Furthermore, all other Codified Ordinances not specifically amended herein shall remain in effect unless inconsistent with this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. The Clerk of Council is authorized and directed to forward a certified copy of this Ordinance to the Codifier of the Village of Mayfield.

SECTION 4. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the residents of Mayfield Village, Ohio. It shall, therefore, take effect immediately upon the passage by the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members elected to Council and approval by the Mayor or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.
