**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE
AMENDING CODIFIED ORDINANCE SECTION 141.01
BY ADOPTING NEW CODIFIED ORDINANCE SUBSECTION 141.01(h)
RELATING TO THE APPOINTMENT OF FIRE FIGHTERS
AT OR BELOW THEIR 32ND BIRTHDAY.**

WHEREAS, at the request of the Village's Fire Chief and Civil Service Commission, it is their collective recommendation that new Codified Ordinance Section 141.01(h) be adopted; and

WHEREAS, the request has been reviewed by the Village's Ordinance Review Committee and recommended for approval by Council; and

WHEREAS, based upon the recommendation of the Ordinance Review Committee the Village Council deems it in the best interest of the Village and its residents and for the efficient operations of the Fire Department to amend Codified Ordinance Section 141.01.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF MAYFIELD VILLAGE, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. Section 141.01(h) of the Village's Codified Ordinances shall be adopted to read as more fully set forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2. All other provisions of the Village Codified Ordinances not inconsistent herewith shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. The Clerk of Council is authorized and directed to forward a certified copy of this Ordinance to the Codifier of the Village of Mayfield.

SECTION 4. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the residents of Mayfield Village, Ohio. It shall, therefore, take effect immediately upon the passage by the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members elected to Council and approval by the Mayor or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.
