**AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION
APPROVING THE RECOMMENDATION
OF THE PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION
WITH RESPECT TO THE
WILDCAT PARK PROJECT
AT THE MAYFIELD HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETIC AREA.**

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission at its regular meeting on February 6, 2012, passed a motion to recommend to Council the approval of the Wildcat Project at the Mayfield High School Athletic Area; and

WHEREAS, Council moves to approve the Project based upon the Planning and Zoning Commission's recommendation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF MAYFIELD VILLAGE, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The action of the Planning and Zoning Commission at its February 6, 2012 regular meeting recommending to Council the approval of the Wildcat Park Project is hereby confirmed by Council.

SECTION 2. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of the Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of Mayfield Village. It shall, therefore, take effect immediately upon passage by the

affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members elected to Council and approval by the Mayor or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.


