**AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION  
TO ADOPT THE SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN  
FOR THE CUYAHOGA COUNTY  
SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT DISTRICT**

WHEREAS, the Village of Mayfield is located within the jurisdiction of the Cuyahoga County Solid Waste Management District ("District"); and

WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga County Solid Waste Management District Policy Committee prepared and adopted a final draft of the Solid Waste Management Plan Update in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Sections 3734.53, 3734.54 and 3734.55; and

WHEREAS, the District provided a copy of the Cuyahoga County Solid Waste Management Plan Update (2013-2028) for ratification to each of the legislative authorities of the District; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Mayfield must decide whether it approves of said Solid Waste Management Plan Update no later than November 17, 2012.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF MAYFIELD VILLAGE, OHIO, THAT:**

SECTION 1. The Village of Mayfield approves the Cuyahoga County Solid Waste Management Plan Update.

SECTION 2. The Clerk is hereby directed to send the District a copy of this resolution to the attention of Diane T. Bickett, Executive Director, Cuyahoga County Solid Waste Management District, 4750 East 131<sup>st</sup> Street, Garfield Heights, Ohio 44105.

SECTION 3. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of the Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of Mayfield Village. It shall, therefore, take effect immediately upon passage by the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members elected to Council and approval by the Mayor or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.




