

**AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION
AUTHORIZING MAYFIELD VILLAGE TO PURCHASE
TWO 2019 FORD F-550 DUMP TRUCKS FROM
VALLEY FORD TRUCK, INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$106,116.00**

WHEREAS, based upon recommendation, it has been deemed in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of all Village residents and inhabitants to acquire two new dump trucks with upgraded dump bodies/hoists and LED lighting packages; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Mayfield takes pride in properly maintaining the Village and the Mayfield Village Department of Public Service provides these services; and

WHEREAS, the Service Director of the Village of Mayfield has recommended that two 2019 Ford F-550 dump trucks be purchased from Valley Ford Truck, Inc. through the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program in the amount of \$106,116.00.

WHEREAS, the Village of Mayfield, upon the recommendation of the Service Director, wishes to purchase two 2019 Ford F-550 dump trucks from Valley Ford Truck, Inc.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF MAYFIELD VILLAGE, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Council of Mayfield Village hereby approves and authorizes an expenditure in the amount of \$106,116.00 to Valley Ford Truck, Inc. for the purchase of two 2019 Ford F-550 dump trucks.

SECTION 2. The Council of Mayfield Village does hereby direct the Mayor and President of Council to enter into contract with Valley Ford Truck, Inc. for the purchase of two 2019 Ford F-550 dump trucks.

SECTION 3. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution have been taken at open meeting of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of health, safety and welfare of the residents of Mayfield Village, Ohio, for the reason that it provides equipment necessary to fulfill the obligations of the Department of Public Safety as set forth in Chapter 137 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Mayfield. It shall, therefore, take effect immediately upon the passage by the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members elected to Council and approved by the Mayor or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.
