

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-30

**AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION DECLARING IT UNNECESSARY
TO RENEW BY LEVY A TAX IN EXCESS OF THE
10-MILL LIMITATION**

WHEREAS, in 1975 the voters of Mayfield Village passed a 2.3 mill tax levy outside of the 10-mill limitations for operating expenses in accordance with Division A of Section 5705.19 of the Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, said levy is renewable every five years; and

WHEREAS, said levy has been approved by the voters seven times since its first passage in 1975; and

WHEREAS, said levy results in no increased taxes; and

WHEREAS, said levy generates \$131,000 per year in the General Fund for operating expenses; and

WHEREAS, said levy will expire on December 31, 2019 and if determined to be necessary to place it on the ballot, said levy would need to be submitted to the electors of Mayfield Village, Ohio at the general election to be held at the usual voting places within said municipality in November 2019; and

WHEREAS, upon recommendation of the Mayor and Finance Director, it has been determined that it is not necessary to renew the levy for an additional five years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF MAYFIELD VILLAGE, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. That upon recommendation by the Mayor and Finance Director, Council declares that it is not necessary to renew the tax in the amount of 2.3 mills outside the 10-mill limitation.

SECTION 2. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution have been taken at open meeting of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took

place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of health, safety and welfare of the residents of Mayfield Village, Ohio, for the reason that funds generated by the levy are not currently needed for operating expenses making renewal of the levy unnecessary. It shall, therefore, take effect immediately upon the passage by the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members elected to Council and approved by the Mayor or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.
