Introduction: Meg called the meeting to order at 7:06 p.m. Mary made a motion to approve the January 15, 2020 Minutes as written and Mary Ann seconded. All committee members in attendance agreed.

Senior Program Updates

- The next Commission on Aging meeting is Thursday, March 12, 2020, at 11 a.m. in the Community Room.
- Bob Perna, a former member of the Commission on Aging, passed away February 6.
- About 100 seniors attended the Trip Preview Program in January. Many trips are already sold out.
- There are two trips in March: Miss Molly's Tea Room and Franklin Park Conservatory.
- Lunch and movie programs are held monthly with CPA and Governor's Village.

Entertainment Committee Minutes

- The committee members reviewed the schedule and recommended that Shane add two more acts in August.
- The entertainment brochure will be re-vamped next year. This will be done every few years.
- Shane was able to secure \$7,000 in ad sponsorships; it covers the cost of the brochure.
- The Village is looking for two interns to work 30-40 hours a week. They will cover events at The Grove including selling t-shirts. They will also split their time with summer camp and other programs.
- Donations collected at The Grove will go towards local organizations and benefits. With money that has been and continues to be collected for the Mayfield Memorial Scholarship in honor of Debbie Hudacko, Shane is looking at increasing the scholarship. He is looking to expand the longevity of the \$500 received by each Mayfield student so they would get \$500 during each of the four years they are in college.

Activities Committee Minutes

- Danielle reported that volunteer sign-up sheets are being passed around for Mother's Day Pancake Breakfast and the Easter Party.
- Last year the committee discussed having a raffle for the plantings that are the backdrop for the picture area of the Pancake Breakfast. Danielle said she will ask the Service Department for more detail about the items so the committee can determine how to structure the raffle. She hopes to have more information at the March meeting.
- The committee members discussed details for the Easter Party that will be held on Saturday, April 4. The party will be from 1:30-3:00 p.m. This year the event will feature a magician as the committee members suggested alternating entertainment/activities each year.

Youth/Family Committee Minutes

- Sean said he is working on the planning for a Father/Daughter or Mother/Son Dance. He would like to form a committee so that the group can plan the event. The event would probably take place in January or February of 2021.
- Sean is also working on a kids cooking session. The idea is to have a small group of Mayfield School District 5th-7th graders learn things such as knife skills, safety, making different dishes, etc. He is looking into finding a professional chef. The 6 week session will end with the students cooking dinner for their family members/friends. Those attending the dinner would buy a table/seat.

Open Discussion

- Danielle said that interviewers are needed for the Mayfield Memorial Scholarship in Honor of Debbie Hudacko scholarship on March 6. Elizabeth, Kate and Laura volunteered.
- Shane said The Grove is going to host a Women's Wellness event in June. Village Resident June Sladek is organizing it.
- Danielle congratulated Troy Koch and the Special Olympics Basketball team for making it to the Final Four of the State Games at Bowling Green State University. Danielle said as far as she knew, this is the farthest the team has made it. Troy was instrumental in coordinating communication with Danielle and the team/coach. In addition Troy even filled in as a coach during the regional tournament which helped lead them to the State Tournament.
- Shane mentioned that the Village will be celebrating its Centennial in 2021. Recreation and Administration Departments are working on planning already. The plan is to have a one day event at The Grove and also have Parkview Pool open the last day of the season just for Mayfield Village Residents.
- Council awarded Licursi Home & Garden the bid for the Parkview Playground Project. With the alternates included, the project will run approximately \$868,000.
- This year 2 out of the 3 softball fields will be renovated in the Fall and storage sheds will be added near the pool and softball fields.
- The meeting ended at 7:30 p.m.
