## CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) UPDATE

June 1, 2020

Dear Residents,

The COVID-19 pandemic continues to make it difficult to safely open Village facilities and move forward with regular programming. I am encouraged that the steps we have taken have resulted in reduced hospitalizations and deaths and I intend to continue to follow Ohio Governor Mike DeWine and Director of Health Amy Acton's guidance as we slowly reopen our facilities.

The most recent order issued by Director Acton, dated May 29, 2020, prohibits "all public and private gatherings of greater than 10 people occurring outside a single household and connected property, or living unit, and connected property" except for the limited purposes permitted in the Order. The Order specifically states that this limitation does not apply to gatherings at your home or property, but continues to prohibit meetings or gatherings at our public facilities. This Order is in effect through July 1, 2020, and based upon it, we issued the enclosed Press Release.

Following is a summary of some important updates:

**RE-OPENING VILLAGE FACILITIES.** Some Village facilities, including Parkview Pool, the softball fields, tennis courts and bocce courts, will open in mid-June. The Civic Center and Community Room will remain closed for meetings, programming and private rentals through July 1, 2020.

**VILLAGE PERSONNEL.** All non-essential Village personnel continue to work remotely from home and our safety forces remain ready to assist you; call 911 for emergency. General questions or comments should be sent to [contactus@mayfieldvillage.com](mailto:contactus@mayfieldvillage.com).

**PARKVIEW POOL will open on Thursday, June 18,** to Village residents and their guests only. The number of people permitted at the pool at one time will be limited and reservations will be required. All CDC guidelines for safe opening will be followed and all patrons will be required to wear a mask when entering and exiting the pool. Details regarding hours, cost and restrictions are being prepared and, as soon as they are complete, will be posted at [www.mayfieldvillage.com/recreation/parkview-pool](http://www.mayfieldvillage.com/recreation/parkview-pool).

**SPECIAL EVENTS.** All Special Events during this period have been cancelled, including JULY 4<sup>TH</sup> FIREWORKS, scheduled for June 27, 2020. The entire 2020 entertainment season at THE GROVE and the GAZEBO has also been cancelled.


**RETURNING TO OHIO.** Travelers coming to or returning to Ohio are no longer required to self-isolate for 14 days.

**SENIOR PROGRAMING** will not resume until further notice. **June 1, 2020**

***Mayfield Village Extends Building Closures and Suspension of  
All Non-Essential Meetings through July 1, 2020***

Mayfield Village, OH (June 1, 2020) – In support of the continuing efforts to prevent the spread of COVID-19 in the State of Ohio, and in compliance with the Ohio Director of Health’s Order dated May 29, 2020, prohibiting the gathering of greater than 10 people outside a single household or living unit, Mayfield Village has extended its building closures and suspension of all non-essential and in-person meetings **through July 1, 2020.**

- The following special events have been cancelled:  
  
6/21 – International Day of Yoga  
6/27 – July 4<sup>th</sup> Fireworks
- Red Cross Blood Drives will continue to be scheduled at the Mayfield Village Civic Center. Upcoming Blood Drives are scheduled on June 4, July 2, and July 15 from 2 to 6:30 p.m. Please note that appointments are required and can be made at [www.redcrossblood.org](http://www.redcrossblood.org) or by calling 1-800-REDCROSS.
- The Civic Center and Community Room will remain closed to the public through July 1, 2020. All Village Departments remain operational, with some office employees continuing to work from home during this period. All calls and e-mails will continue to be answered.
- The Community Room and all pavilions will remain closed to private rentals through July 1, 2020. Full refunds will be issued for all cancelled rentals.
- Parkview Pool will open on June 18, subject to all mandatory procedures and best practices set forth in the ResponsibleRestart Ohio guidelines. Admission will be limited to Mayfield Village residents only and other restrictions will apply. Details will be posted at [www.mayfieldvillage.com/recreation/parkview-pool](http://www.mayfieldvillage.com/recreation/parkview-pool).
- All concerts scheduled at The Grove and the Gazebo are cancelled for the 2020 season.
- Most Recreational and Senior programs will remain cancelled during this period. Check [www.mayfieldvillage.com/recreation](http://www.mayfieldvillage.com/recreation) for updates on activities that are permitted to resume.

- Village tennis courts and bocce courts will open on June 15, subject to posted guidelines and restrictions. The Greenway Trail remains open for walking, running and biking. Users are asked to follow all CDC guidelines.
- All table, chair and tool rentals and deliveries by the Service Department are suspended until further notice.
- The Regular Meeting of Council scheduled for June 15, 2020 at 7:00 p.m. will be held remotely, via electronic means, and will be made available for viewing by the public. See the Village's website at [www.mayfieldvillage.com](http://www.mayfieldvillage.com) for agendas and updated meeting information.
- Commissions, Boards or Committees that must meet to conduct business will continue to do so remotely and all meetings will be made available for viewing by the public. See the Village's website at [www.mayfieldvillage.com](http://www.mayfieldvillage.com) for agendas and updated meeting information.
- Weekly trash and recycling pickup remain on the normal schedule and all previously-imposed limitations have been removed. Simple Recycling has also resumed pickup of soft recyclables on its normal schedule.


## Cloth face coverings/masks DOs and DON'Ts

# PREVENTION

Some people with COVID-19 have no symptoms and can spread the virus to others who are close by, through speaking, coughing, sneezing, or other means.

To help prevent this, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) has recommended that people wear cloth face coverings (masks) in public settings, such as grocery stores, to help slow the spread of COVID-19.



**DO** practice 6-foot social distancing even if you are wearing a face covering.



**DO** buy a covering or make one from household or common materials. Use multiple layers of a fabric that does not lose shape when laundered or machine dried.



**DO** wear face coverings so they fit snugly but comfortably and allow for breathing without restriction. Secure behind the head with ties or ear loops.



**DO** wear horizontally. Ensure that your nose, mouth, and chin are covered at all times.



**DO** wash your hands before putting on and immediately after removing.



**DO** regularly launder coverings in a washing machine.



**DO NOT** place cloth face coverings on children under age 2, or anyone unable to remove them without assistance.



**DO NOT** touch the mask while wearing it. If you do, wash your hands immediately.




**DO NOT** allow the mask to slip under your nose or chin.



**DO NOT** untie straps/unhook ear loops while wearing.



**DO NOT** touch your eyes, nose, or mouth when removing the face covering.



**DO NOT** wear when wet from laundering or from spit or mucus.
