***Mayfield Village Extends Building Closures Through July 7, 2020***

Mayfield Village, OH (June 30, 2020) – Mayfield Village has extended its building closures and suspension of all non-essential and in-person meetings through July 7, 2020, pending updated orders from Governor Mike DeWine’s Office, expected later this week.

- Red Cross Blood Drives will continue to be scheduled at the Mayfield Village Civic Center. Upcoming Blood Drives are scheduled on July 2, July 15 and July 28 from 2 to 6:30 p.m. Please note that appointments are required and can be made at [www.redcrossblood.org](http://www.redcrossblood.org) or by calling 1-800-REDCROSS.
- The Civic Center and Community Room will remain closed to the public through July 7, 2020. All Village Departments remain operational, with some office employees continuing to work from home during this period. All calls and e-mails will continue to be answered.
- The Community Room and all pavilions will remain closed to private rentals through July 7, 2020. Full refunds will be issued for all cancelled rentals.
- Most Recreational and Senior programs remain cancelled during this period. Check [www.mayfieldvillage.com/recreation](http://www.mayfieldvillage.com/recreation) for updates on activities that are permitted to resume.
- Parkview Pool, the Greenway Trail, and Village tennis courts and bocce courts are open to the public, subject to posted guidelines and restrictions. All playgrounds remain closed.
