Mayfield Village Extends Building Closures and Suspension of In-Person Meetings

Mayfield Village, OH (July 9, 2020) – In support of the continuing efforts to prevent the spread of COVID-19 in the State of Ohio, and in compliance with Governor DeWine’s order extending the ban on mass gatherings of more than 10 people outside a single household or living unit, except for specific situations, Mayfield Village has extended its building closures and suspension of all non-essential and in-person meetings **until further notice**.

- Red Cross Blood Drives will continue to be scheduled at the Mayfield Village Civic Center. Upcoming Blood Drives are scheduled on July 15, July 28 and August 20 from 2 to 6:30 p.m. Please note that appointments are required and can be made at www.redcrossblood.org or by calling 1-800-REDCROSS.
- The Civic Center and Community Room will remain closed to the public. All Village Departments remain operational and all calls and e-mails will continue to be answered. An in-person appointment with a particular Department can be scheduled by calling 440-461-2210. Face coverings will be required to enter any Village-owned buildings.
- The Community Room and all pavilions will remain closed to private rentals. Full refunds will be issued for all cancelled rentals.
- Most Recreational and Senior programs will remain cancelled during this period. Check www.mayfieldvillage.com/recreation for updates on activities that are permitted to resume.
- Parkview Pool, Village tennis courts and bocce courts, and the Greenway Trail are open to the public, subject to posted guidelines and restrictions. Playgrounds and pavilions remain closed but are expected to open in August, subject to posted guidelines and restrictions.
- All Council Caucus and Regular meetings will continue to be held remotely, via electronic means, and will be made available for viewing by the public. See the Village’s website at www.mayfieldvillage.com for agendas and updated meeting information.
