**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE
AMENDING EXHIBIT 1 TO
VILLAGE ORDINANCE NUMBER 2017-15
TO ADD THE POSITION OF
“PROGRAM AND FACILITIES MANAGER”
WITHIN THE RECREATION DEPARTMENT**

WHEREAS, Ordinance Number 2017-15 provides for wages, benefits, and other terms and conditions of employment for employees of Mayfield Village, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, it has been deemed in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of all Village residents to specifically amend Exhibit 1 of Ordinance Number 2017-15 relative to the Recreation Department and the addition of the position of “Program and Facilities Manager”.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF MAYFIELD VILLAGE, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. Exhibit 1 of Village Ordinance Number 2017-15 be amended to add the position of “Program and Facilities Manager” within the Recreation Department. The “Low Salary Range” for this position shall be \$40,842 and the “Low Hourly Range” for this position shall be \$19.64. The “2018 Salary Range” for this position shall be \$50,209.41, the “2018 Hourly Range” for this position shall be \$24.14, the “2019 Salary Range” for this position shall be \$55,215.69, and the “2019 Hourly Range” for this position shall be \$26.55.

SECTION 2. All other provisions of the Village’s Codified Ordinances not inconsistent herewith shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the residents of Mayfield Village, Ohio. It shall, therefore, take effect immediately upon the passage by the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members elected to Council and approval by the Mayor or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.


