**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE COMPENSATION OF THE MAYOR,
PRESIDENT OF COUNCIL AND MEMBERS OF COUNCIL**

WHEREAS, Article III, Section 6 of the Charter of Mayfield Village provides that the Council shall have the power to fix all compensation paid by the Municipality and the salary of its own members; and

WHEREAS, Article III, Section 6 of the Charter of Mayfield Village also requires that any increase in compensation for the Village Council or the Mayor be passed by Ordinance and submitted to the Village electorate for approval by majority vote; and

WHEREAS, after consideration of the responsibilities and obligations of the Mayor and Council members, it has been determined that it is in the best interest of the Village to amend the compensation of the Mayor, President of Council and Members of Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of Mayfield Village, Cuyahoga County, State of Ohio that:

SECTION 1. The compensation for the Mayor, Council President and Village Council Members shall be fixed at: \$50,000 per annum and health benefits for the Mayor; \$12,100 per annum for the Council President; and \$11,000 per annum for Council Members. Such compensation shall take effect on January 1, 2021.

SECTION 2. This ordinance upon adoption by Council shall be referred to the Clerk of Cuyahoga County Board of Elections not later than sixty (60) days before the November 3, 2020 election.


SECTION 3. By authority of this Ordinance, the Board of Election is authorized and directed to place on the ballot for the electors of Mayfield Village, at the November 3, 2020 the following question:

**SHALL THE COMPENSATION OF THE MAYOR, COUNCIL
PRESIDENT AND COUNCIL MEMBERS BE FIXED AS FOLLOWS: FOR
THE MAYOR, \$50,000 PER ANNUM AND HEALTH INSURANCE
BENEFITS; FOR THE COUNCIL PRESIDENT \$12,100 PER ANNUM;
AND FOR MEMBERS OF COUNCIL, \$11,000 PER ANNUM,
COMMENCING JANUARY 1, 2021?**

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law and upon signature of the Mayor.

SECTION 5. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance have been taken at open meetings of this Council and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meeting open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


