**AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING CODIFIED ORDINANCE SECTION 131.10 RELATING TO
FOOD AND BEVERAGE PURCHASES FOR MEETINGS AND FUNDRAISERS**

WHEREAS, it has become necessary to revise Codified Ordinance Section 131.10 regarding the Mayor's authority to make food and beverage purchases for meetings and fundraisers; and

WHEREAS, Village Council deems it in the best interest of the Village and its residents to amend Codified Ordinance Section 131.10 as set forth below.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of Mayfield Village, Cuyahoga County, State of Ohio that:

SECTION 1. Section 131.10 of the Village's Codified Ordinances as enacted be amended to read as fully set forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2. All other provisions of the Village Codified Ordinances not inconsistent herewith shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. The Clerk of Council is authorized and directed to forward a certified copy of this Ordinance to the Codifier of Mayfield Village.

SECTION 4. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance have been taken at open meetings of this Council and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meeting open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect after adoption and at the earliest time allowed by law.

EXHIBIT A

131.10 Food and Beverage Purchases for Meetings and Fund-Raisers

The Mayor is hereby authorized to purchase food and beverages for meetings of any public body, board, commission, public officer(s) or public employee(s), and fund-raising events for obtaining money for the general fund, whenever such meetings and/or fund-raisers are for the purpose of benefiting the taxpayers of the Village, either by way of raising additional monies for the General Fund or some special fund of the Village, or for conducting public business, including employee appreciation and/or recognition, all of which shall be considered as the furthering of a public purpose. The Mayor shall be authorized to spend not more than that amount authorized by Council in the budget from year to year, without additional approval needed from Council, for food and beverage purchases.
