**AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION
AUTHORIZING MAYFIELD VILLAGE TO EXPEND FUNDS
IN THE AMOUNT OF \$10,770.00 TO
HICAP RENOVATIONS FOR POWER WASHING AND
STAINING OF THE GREENWAY TRAIL BOARDWALK**

WHEREAS, based upon recommendation, it has been deemed in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of all Village residents and inhabitants to power wash and stain the Greenway Trail Boardwalk; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Mayfield takes pride in properly maintaining the green space within the Village and the Mayfield Village Department of Public Service diligently maintains this green space; and

WHEREAS, the Greenway Trial has approximately 22,500 square feet of boardwalks, bridges and handrails that are in need of maintenance; and

WHEREAS, Doug Metzger, the Service Director of the Village of Mayfield has recommended that HICAP Renovations be hired to power wash and stain the Greenway Trial Boardwalk after reviewing several quotes from reputable suppliers;

WHEREAS, the Village of Mayfield, upon the recommendation of the Service Director, wishes to hire HICAP Renovations to power wash and stain the Greenway Trail Boardwalk.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF MAYFIELD VILLAGE, OHIO, THAT:


SECTION 1. The Council of Mayfield Village hereby approves and authorizes an expenditure of \$10,770.00 to HICAP Renovations to power wash and stain the Greenway Trail Boardwalk.

SECTION 2. The Council of Mayfield Village does hereby direct the Mayor and President of Council to enter into contract with HICAP Renovations to power wash and stain the Greenway Trail Boardwalk.

SECTION 3. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution have been taken at open meeting of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took

place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of health, safety and welfare of the residents of Mayfield Village, Ohio, for the reason that it provides services necessary to fulfill obligations set forth in Chapter 137 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Mayfield. It shall, therefore, take effect immediately upon the passage by the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members elected to Council and approved by the Mayor or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.



Scope of work:

Power wash and stain approximately 22,500 square feet of boardwalks, bridges and handrails along the Greenway Trail.

Contractor to provide all necessary equipment. Work will be completed by uniformed and Insured qualified professional painters. Contractor to provide workers compensation for all personnel on project. Project will be completed with every effort made to not impede guests of the trail. All walkways will be kept open at all times, painted in a way to provide one half of the walking path designated for foot traffic, caution tape will be used to protect visitors from wet paint, along with appropriate signage on display at every job site. Contractor will provide the stain product, CWF Flood, as per request by the service department. Product to be applied per factory specifications and guidelines. Weather permitting, project projected to take 15 work days to complete.
