



## THORNAPPLE – ROBLEY SEWER PROJECT

- Cuyahoga County Department of Public Works will be providing sewer construction inspection for Mayfield Village.
- Once the project is accepted the Board of Health will be notifying residents that they can connect to the sewer system and abandon their home treatment systems (septic tanks).
- Homeowners need to select a contractor from the County's list of Registered Contractors. The list of registered contractors can be found at: <http://publicworks.cuyahogacounty.us/en-US/permits-licenses.aspx>  
It is a six-page list.
- The contractor will need to pull a septic abandonment permit from the Board of Health and sewer permit fee from the County. The County's Board of Health abandonment fee is \$100.00; the County Department of Public Works sewer permit fee is \$245.00.

- There are costs to the homeowner to abandon the septic tank and to install the sewer lateral from the house to the connection point at the ROW provided by the sewer construction project.
- The County's Department of Development has two programs to assist homeowners in financing the work on their properties.
- There is the HELP (Housing Enhancement Loan Program) through Key Bank and Huntington Bank. This is a low interest loan program.
- There is also the Four Component (4COM) Home Repair Loan Program. This can be a 0% loan to residents over 62 years of age and low interest program. There are income eligibility requirements for this program.
