

# Thornapple/Robley Septic to Sanitary Sewer Conversion

## PROJECT UPDATE - April 6, 2018

Thanks to those of you that attended the resident meeting on March 27. The materials provided at the meeting are available on our website at [www.mayfieldvillage.com](http://www.mayfieldvillage.com).

Fabrizi Trucking & Paving expects to begin work on this project during the week of April 16. The Village-owned property at SOM Center and Thornapple will be used as a staging area for equipment and materials. In order to complete this project in one season, Fabrizi intends to utilize two separate crews, one on each street. Please use available alternate routes to enter and exit the neighborhood when possible.

**DRIVEWAY APRONS.** This project includes the installation of new concrete driveway aprons at each property. Please note that there will be no exceptions; all aprons will be replaced in concrete.

**MAILBOXES.** Fabrizi will remove all mailboxes and posts and place them in your front yard during the project. Temporary boxes will be provided. Fabrizi's landscape crew will reset all posts and boxes at the end of the project. If you would like to replace your mailbox or post, please make your purchases during this period and the new box and/or post will be installed.

**STAKING OF CONNECTIONS.** Beginning on Wed, April 11, the Village Engineer's Office will stake each property to show the proposed location of sanitary sewer lateral connections. If you have a question about the proposed location or desire any changes, please contact the Engineer's Office immediately at 216-731-6255.
