

Thornapple/Robley Septic to Sanitary Sewer Conversion

ROAD CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

Mayfield Village is preparing to move forward with the conversion of septic to sanitary sewers on Thornapple Drive, Robley Lane and portions of Wilson Mills Road. This project will involve the installation of new water, storm and sanitary sewer lines and replacement of the roadway.

Fabrizi Trucking & Paving has been awarded this project. Work is expected to begin on April 16 with completion of the entire project by Nov 2018.

On the reverse side of this notice is a map of the area. In order to complete this project in one season, Fabrizi will utilize two separate crews, one working on Thornapple and one on Robley. Marked in red on the map are the areas where the crews will be working. **Please use available alternate routes to enter and exit the neighborhood as much as possible.**

Please note that the Village-owned property at SOM Center and Thornapple will be used as a staging area for equipment and materials.

It will be most difficult for residents on Eastgate and Meadowood to exit the neighborhood as there is no route to get to SOM Center that does not go through the construction area. We have asked Fabrizi to ensure that ingress and egress is maintained at all times.
