

**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING
RECREATIONAL WAGES**

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Director has recommended wage ranges for certain positions that will be used in servicing recreation in the Village of Mayfield.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF MAYFIELD VILLAGE, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The following positions and wage ranges are established for recreation in the Village of Mayfield:

Pool Manager	\$12.00-\$20.25
Assistant Pool Manager	\$11.75-\$18.00
Snack Bar Manager	\$11.75-\$19.00
Snack Bar Supervisor	\$9.70-\$13.00
Learn to Swim Coordinator	\$11.75-\$16.00
Head Lifeguard	\$9.70-\$17.00
Lifeguard	Ohio Minimum Wage-\$15.00
Lifeguard with WSI (Water Safety Instructor)	\$9.70-\$16.00
Head Cashier	\$9.70-\$14.00
Cashier	Ohio Minimum Wage-\$11.00
Checker/Pool Attendant	Ohio Minimum Wage-\$11.00
Parkview Maintenance	Ohio Minimum Wage-\$14.00
Snack Bar Attendant	Ohio Minimum Wage-\$12.00
Head Coach	\$350.00-\$700.00 per season
Assistant Coach	\$300.00-\$500.00 per season
Special Program Water Instructor	\$200.00 per season or negotiable
Part-Time Recreational Specialist	Ohio Minimum Wage-\$14.00

SECTION 2. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the residents of Mayfield Village, Ohio because it provides for employment guidelines for time sensitive positions. It shall, therefore, take effect immediately upon the passage by the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members elected to Council and approval by the Mayor or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.
